There are Four Floors to Explore

First Floor: Explore Seattle's role as a hub for big ideas and new directions in *The Bezos Center for Innovation*. You'll also find some of Seattle's most iconic large artifacts on display.

Second Floor: Travel through the history of the Puget Sound in *True Northwest: The Seattle Journey*. The Walker Gallery features our current special exhibit, ask for more details at the admissions desk.

Third Floor: Step into MOHAI's Kid-Struction Zone for an exciting, hands-on space that sparks creativity and curiosity in young learners.

Fourth Floor: Navigate Seattle's maritime history and enjoy beautiful views over Lake Union.

- Lockers and wheelchairs are available to check out for free at the front desk
- Discovery backpacks for ages 3-10 are available to check out for free at the admissions desk
